HISTORICAL NOTE: By an order on June 3, 1996 from the Arizona Superior Court, the Arizona Historical Foundation was mandated to keep a permanent copy of all records relating to water rights and the Gila River Indian Community. Periodically, records will be sent to the Foundation to be arranged and preserved. This is an active collection.

SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE: These records contain documents relevant to the Gila River Indian Community and water rights issues. The collection is comprised of five series; **Series I: Arizona Department of Water Resources, Series II: Arizona General Stream Adjudication, Series III: Cox and Cox Attorneys; Series IV: Gookin Engineers Ltd., Series V: Salt River Project (SRP).** Documents are arranged by date within each series except for **Series V: SRP** where the documents are arranged by document number. Those without document numbers are arranged by date.

Many of the records are full reports which contain maps and other informational materials. Of interest in **Series III** is a reprinted report from 1924 by Carl Hayden entitled *A History of the Pima Indians and the San Carlos Irrigation Project* which is Hayden's own research about this community.
