SCOPE AND CONTENT NOTE:

Background: The Small Manuscript collection is an active, artificial collection begun circa 1960 in an effort to aggregate historical materials, orphan documents, unpublished works, and fragmented personal papers into a “ready reference” for students. These materials were of insufficient quantity (5 folders or less) to merit a stand alone status. The donations came from multiple sources ranging from family histories for class assignments to items purchased from historical document dealers. The collection includes correspondence, eye witness reports, genealogies, diaries, old newspaper clippings, reminiscences, short stories, early histories of cities and towns, small maps, surveys, and military documents.

Reappraisal: After 50 years of accumulations, a reappraisal of this collection was conducted to evaluate its strengths, eliminate redundancies, and identify unique materials. The process included weeding for duplicates, combining subject files, evaluating physical condition, checking for titles and accuracy against entries in the Special Materials Index on the ASU library catalog.

The criteria used to determine the strengths of this collection were as follows: materials that provide insight into experiences of Arizonans from different perspectives; fresh and unique points of view on events in Arizona history; and materials that represent different political, cultural and minority experiences.

The overall condition of the materials is excellent and most fragile materials have been copied for researcher use.

Highlights: The strengths of this collection are the primary sources under the following headings.

Territorial Arizona: A Summer Trip Among the Strange People and Strange Places of Great American Desert in America, 1901; Black Cowboys in the Territory of Arizona, 1984; Report on the Water Supply of the Agua Fria River and the Storage Reservoir Project of the Agua Fria Water and Land, 1903; Territory of Arizona vs. Doc Holliday et al, March 25, 1882; Proceedings against Sylvester Mowry in the Arizona Territory, 1862.
