BIOGRAPHICAL SKETCH

John H. Armer and A. Cone Webb, longtime partners in the cattle business, founded the Tonto Basin Cattle Company in 1911. The Armers and the Webbs were important ranch families and lifelong residents of Gila County, Arizona, united through the years by ties of both business and marriage.

SCOPE AND CONTENT

The A. Cone Webb Collection consists of biographical information and documents. The biographical series includes a family history by Frank Armer, as well as information about Charles Clifford Griffin, who was both Frank Armer's grandfather and A. Cone Webb's father-in-law. The document series includes documents regarding the founding of the Tonto Basin Cattle Company, and business papers (mortgages, deeds, bills of sale) of several members of the Webb family.
